*** **Asynchronous Learning** offers students the flexibility to complete assignments in a self-paced manner. Lessons may include prerecorded videos made by the teacher or online materials used in class. Lessons and assignments are a continuation of a normal school day.

**** **Synchronous Learning** allows students to engage in class at the same time as their peers via live video conferencing (i.e., Google Meet). Lessons will be conducted over live video, and assignments will be given based on the material discussed during the live lesson. Lessons and assignments are a continuation of a normal school day.
