Scholarships

Below is a brief description of all the scholarships, awards, and opportunities on the scholarship list. For more detailed information on any of these, please click this link:

Goodman Plumbing Scholarship for any “Trades” (Seniors), Deadline: March 31, 2023 - LaPorte County seniors considering a career in the trades, rather than a standard 4-year college degree. Two \$1,000 scholarships.

Music Boosters Scholarship (Seniors), Deadline: March 31, 2023 - This local scholarship honors and promotes music and scholarship in the lives of college-bound seniors.

Construction Advancement Foundation (Seniors), Deadline: March 31, 2023 - Seniors planning to attend trade school or college towards pursuing a career in construction or a related field such as engineering, this scholarship opportunity may be for you.

Westville Tri Kappa (Seniors or current College Students), Deadline: April 10, 2023 - Scholarships are available to South Central and Westville seniors and those currently attending college, who previously attended those high schools. These scholarships are based on academic performance and financial need.

Indiana Sheriffs’ Association Scholarship (Seniors), Deadline: April 1, 2023 - Forty \$750 scholarships to qualified students throughout the state of Indiana who are pursuing an education or career in the criminal justice field.

ICES Bridging Cultures Scholarship (Grades 9-12 Eligible to Apply), Deadline: April 1, 2023 - If you know a globally-minded American teen who's looking for cash for college, here's some great news! South Central Jr.-Sr. High School partners with ICES each year to bring exchange students from various countries to our school. Seven scholarships will be awarded as follows: 1st Place: \$4000; 2nd Place: \$3000; Third Place (5): \$2000 each. Awards are for education-related expenses for undergraduate study only. Awards are one-time only and not renewable. Applicants are required to submit an essay as part of their application.

Unity Foundation Scholarship Applications Now Available Online (Seniors and current college students), Deadline: March 24, 2023 - Seniors, please note that this is different than the Lilly Scholarship. For this, you fill out one general application and you are automatically

considered for numerous scholarships specific to LaPorte County! Scholarship awards average over \$2,000 each. For the 2022-2023 school year, Unity reduced tuition bills worth more than \$330,000 for 150 students

LPCAA-Vocational Scholarship (Seniors), Deadline: May 1, 2023 - The LaPorte County Agricultural Association is offering a \$1250 Scholarship Award to an individual who is pursuing Vocational/Trade School. This scholarship is limited to High School Seniors and current LaPorte County 4-H Members.

Knights of Pythias High School Poster/Visual Arts Contest (Grades 9-12), Deadline: April 1, 2023 - Any two-dimensional medium may be used. Monetary prizes, ranging from \$1,000 to \$100, for first through eighth place will be awarded for national-level winners.

VFW Auxiliary National Singing Contest (Grades K-12), Deadline: March 31, 2023 - Enter this contest for a chance to win prize money. It would require an audio recording of the student singing the National Anthem.

Young American Creative Patriotic (2-D) Art Contest and 3-Dimensional Art Patriotic Art Contest (Grades 9-12), Deadline: March 31, 2023 - Can choose to participate in the 2-D and/or 3-D Patriotic Art Contests for scholarship money.

RaiseMe (High School Students), Deadline: Ongoing - Students enter and can achieve “micro-scholarships” for their various achievements and activities during high school. Things such as course grades and club, sport, and volunteer activities can count. For example, earning an A in a Core class can earn you up to \$1,000 and a leadership role in a sport activity can earn you up to \$1,500. Note, not all colleges and universities participate, but there are many that do. Visit their website at <https://www.raise.me/> to create an account profile.

College Board Big Future Scholarships (Juniors and Sophomores), Deadline: Ongoing - This program is run by the College Board, the same organization that is in charge of the PSAT, SAT, and AP Programs. It doesn't require an essay, application, or minimum GPA. Instead, it rewards your effort and initiative. Complete key steps along your path to college for a chance to earn scholarships. A 2022 South Central grad did earn a \$500 Scholarship! Steps include: Build Your College List - \$500, Practice for the SAT (Khan Academy) - \$1,000, Improve Your Score - \$2,000, Strengthen Your College List - \$500, Complete the FAFSA - \$1,000, Apply to Colleges - \$1,000, Complete the Journey - \$40,000. Students who complete the various steps by the deadlines will be entered into a random drawing to have a chance to win the various money prizes.

American Legion Hoosier Boys State - We are now accepting online applications for American Legion Hoosier Boys State. The 2023 Hoosier Boys State will be held the week of June 11 through June 17 at Trine University. The program is open to boys completing their junior year

of High School. All they have to do is go to www.hoosierboysstate.org and complete the electronic application. They can complete the required school and parental signatures online as well. We will be accepting all boys who are interested & able to attend during this week. The fees will be paid for by a local American Legion Post or community partner.
