Guidance

Seniors - Instructions for Requesting End of Year Transcripts

Requesting your final high school transcript for yourself or college you plan to attend:

Login to your account at <https://www.parchment.com/> and click on "Order" and then follow the directions to select the location(s) that you want your transcript to be sent. All Graduating Seniors are highly encouraged to have a copy sent to your own email so you have this for yourself. After graduation this will show that you have graduated. If you request before graduation, make sure that you request that the transcript is not sent until after grades are posted (so from the pull down menu select "Hold For Grades". Final transcripts will then be sent to the requested locations within a few days after graduation.) Students can log back in to the Parchment webpage to track when the requested transcripts were sent out. (Remember that transcripts are emailed to you as they are on the day that you request them (unless you select "Hold For

Grades” and will not automatically update on your Parchment account. You MUST request an updated copy.)

Students must send final transcripts to the college they will be attending for your financial aid and scholarships to be awarded to you from the college.

Requesting Dual Credit Transcripts for college-level classes you have taken in high school (You must send an official copy to the college you are attending for them to record the classes – being on your high school transcript is NOT enough.):

Note, these MUST be requested by the student (not the Guidance Counselor) directly from the college that you earned the dual credit from and there will likely be a fee that you must pay to the college.

For Ivy Tech classes (most AK Smith classes, all dual credit classes taken with Mr. Bailey, Mr. Masson, Mr. McCallum, Mr. Siford, and Mr. Horn), visit <https://www.ivytech.edu/registrar/3449.html> . You may need your student (C number) to do this. You should be able to find this on your Ivy Tech “Dual Enroll account”, which is how you signed up for the class in the first place. If you can’t locate it, please email Mrs. Randall and she will try to help you locate it. Please know that no South Central staff members (Mrs. Randall nor your dual credit teacher) will be able to access your MyIvy username or password though. You MUST wait until final grades are posted to the college before you request then (so it’s probably a good idea to wait until after graduation).

For IUN classes (Dual Credit Speech, Composition, and Pre Calc and Trig taken with Mr. Schoff), visit this website: https://transcript.iu.edu/?_ga=2.42710117.1739915581.1621001846-654237081.1611754601 . Don’t forget to wait to make your request until after final grades are posted to the college.
