Dyslexia Program:

During the 2021-2022 school year, the South Central Community School Corporation used the research-based program Orton Gillingham Interventions to provide instruction to all students in need of intervention. The program was used in small groups to address any student with a deficit in the areas identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia.

Number of Students Who Received Dyslexia Intervention:

During the 2021-2022 school year, 14 students attending the South Central Community School Corporation received dyslexia intervention services.

Total Number of Students Identified as Exhibiting the Characteristics of Dyslexia

During the 2021-2022 school year, the NWEA Skill Assessment, the Arkansas Rapid Naming Assessment, and the Words Their Way Spelling Assessment were administered to all K-2 students in the South Central Community School Corporation. Of the students who took the screener, 37 were flagged; 14 students received interventions after taking the Level 1 Screener, the HMH iRead Screener; and 0 students were officially diagnosed with characteristics of dyslexia.
